### 1. TRAVEL TO / FROM GENEVA

#### **VISA REQUIREMENTS**

The best place to check whether you need to apply for a visa is <u>here</u>.

#### **TRAVEL EMERGENCY**

If you have booked your flight with TravelPerk and you experience an emergency during your trip, please log in to your TravelPerk account and click on the help section at the top right of the page, then, you can directly talk to one of their agents, who can help you. The support is available 24/7.

We recommend downloading the Travel Perk App for an easy access to your information while travelling.



#### **GENEVA AIRPORT TO GENEVA CITY CENTER**

Geneva airport is well connected to the city center by Train or by Bus. It only takes 10 minutes to get to the main train station, Gare Cornavin.

Anyone staying in approved accommodation in Geneva is entitled to a <u>free transport card</u>.

You will receive a digital version of the "Geneva Transport Card" that enables you to use public transport in Geneva, free of charge, for the duration of your stay.

The card is personal and non-transferable and grants you free access to Geneva's public transport network UNIRESO: buses (TPG), trains (CFF), and boats (Mouettes genevoises). It is unlimited for the entire duration of your stay.

#### **GETTING AROUND GENEVA**

#### **HEALTH SAFETY IN GENEVA**

Masks are no longer mandatory in shops and restaurants as in other public settings (venues and events) and public transportation. During the event, everyone should feel at ease about whether to wear a mask or not, depending on their personal decision.

### **2. STAYING IN GENEVA**

#### **CURRENCY**

Swiss francs (abbr. CHF) is the national currency in Switzerland. Most places accept cash, but it is more common to pay by card.

#### **PLUG AND SOCKETS**

Swiss plugs and sockets are unique, featuring three round pins arranged in a triangular formation. Make sure to bring a universal adapter to ensure compatibility with your electronic devices during your stay.



#### WEATHER

Geneva could be rainy during this period, so be sure to bring along a rain jacket or umbrella. The temperature should be between 6°C and 20°C.


